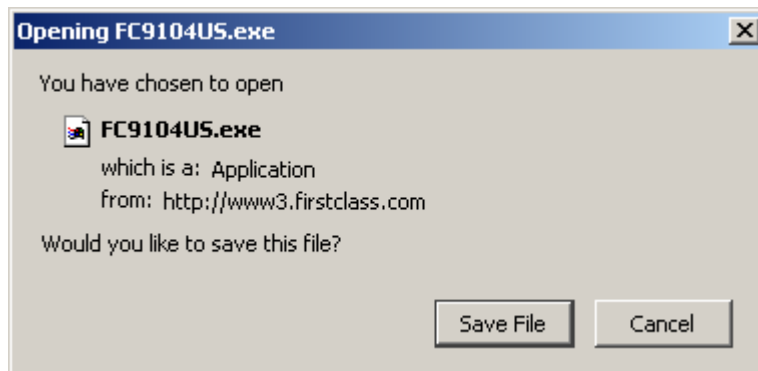
Step 1
To download the Windows version, click the appropriate link in the table below based on your platform and language.

Step 2
Once the installation is complete you will need to configure the client to connect to your local FirstClass Server. Please contact the help desk or IT department of your school or business for this information.

When the Login screen appears, simply enter your user ID and password and click Login.

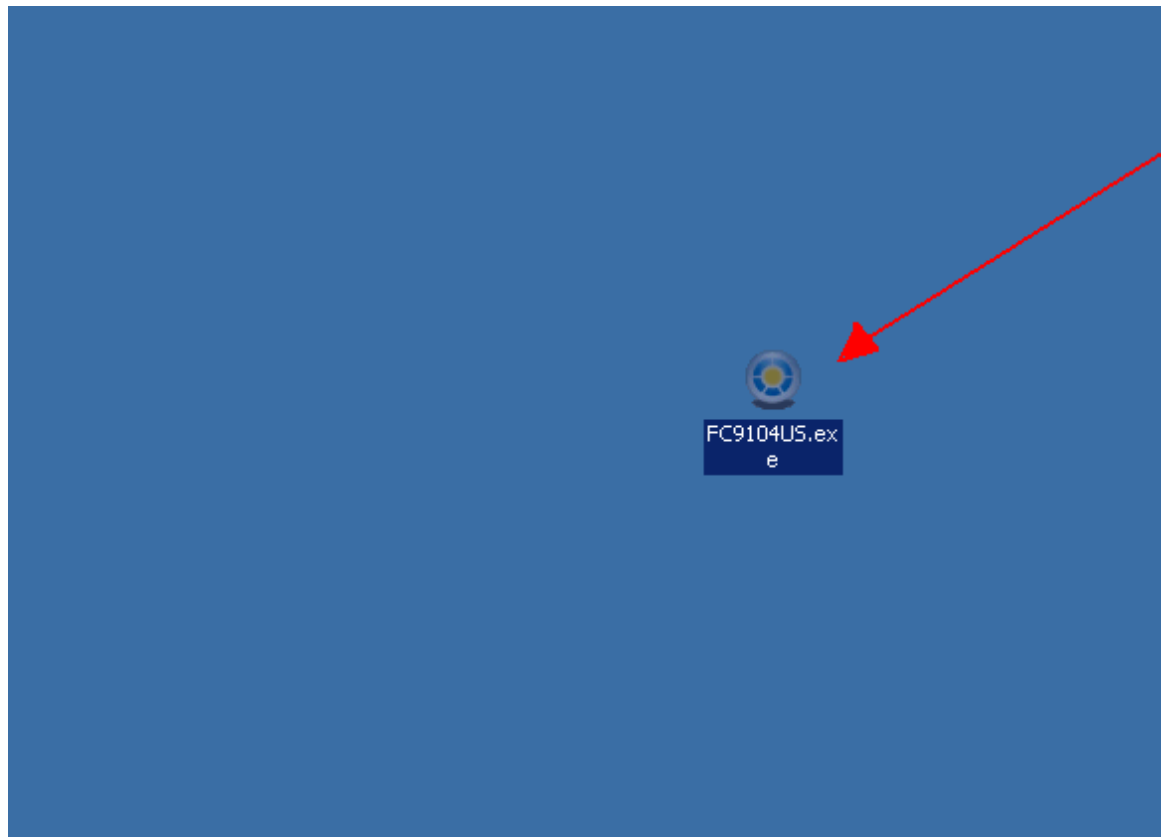

When you Click on the version you would like, you will get a dialog box like this:



Click on “**Save File**” and if you have the option, choose to save the file on your Desktop.

Now, after the file downloads, you should have an icon on your desktop that looks like this:

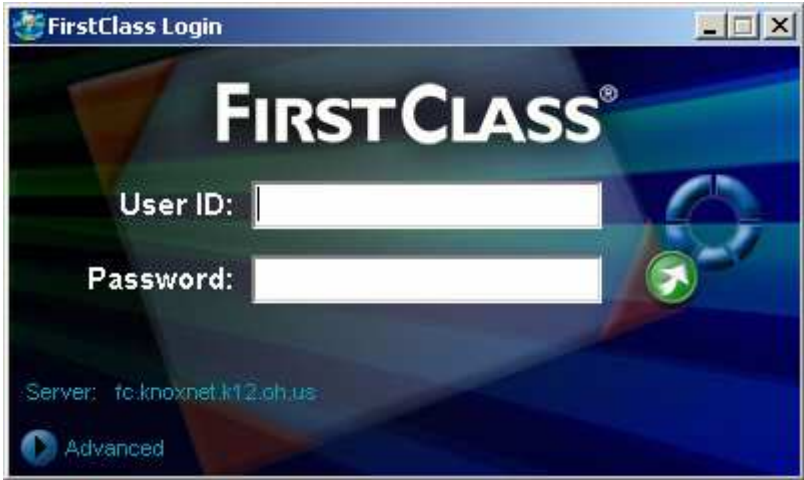


Double click on this icon to install the FirstClass client.

Click on “**next**” then “**yes**” to agree to the license agreement, then keep clicking on “**next**” and accepting the default information until the installer is finished, and finally click on “**finish**” to complete the installation.

Configuring the client:

After the installation process is complete, it will bring you to the login screen:

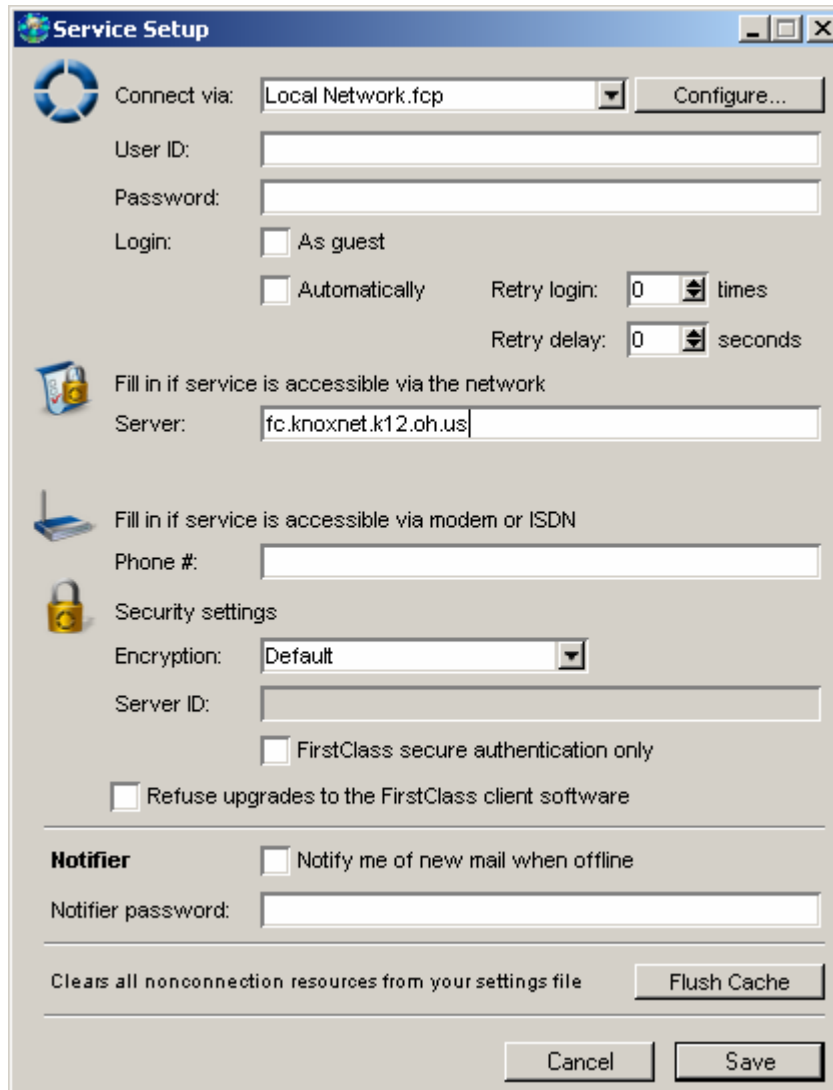


*Note: the information after “server” upon a fresh install of FirstClass may be blank. This is normal.

Click on the Arrow next to “advanced” in the lower-left corner. This will expand the Advanced Options:



Now click on the “setup” button on the right side. This is where we will specify the server name.



The only information we need to worry about here is the “**server**” setting at around the top 1/3rd of the screen. In the server field, type: **fc.knoxnet.k12.oh.us** and make sure it appears the same way as the picture above. Click on “save” and it will bring you back to the login screen. You can once again click on the “**Advanced**” arrow to minimize the login screen if you wish. Now, type in your username (usually first initial and last name all one word) in the “**User ID:**” field, and your specified password in the “**Password**” field and you should be all set to use FirstClass.
